Respect umpires, officials, coaches, players and spectators



Ensure balance between performance and the wider needs of the performer



Respect confidentiality and data



Have the participants best interests at heart

Respect that you're in a position of authority



Never participate under the influence of drugs or alcohol



Competency – ensure relevant certification



Ensure first aid provision



Set and uphold personal boundaries

Personal standards – ensure appropriateness of activities

Ensure the safety of all above all else



Ensure you know the safety procedures for all facilities used



Under 18's should only work with suitably qualified and insured adults



Accept success and failure with dignity



Ensure everyone understands what the code of ethics means for them



Act like the role model you are



Maintain personal standards – image of health and don't smoke in front of participants



Never use or tolerate offensive language front of participants







CODE OF CONDUCT PARENTS AND SPECTATORS

- 1** Focus on effort rather than winning or losing 
- 2** Respect umpires, officials, coaches, players and spectators 
- 3** Inform the coach or captain of any welfare issues 
- 4** Honest effort and teamwork are as important as victory 
- 5** Respect official decisions and teach the young to do the same 
- 6** Remember the young participate for their enjoyment, not yours 
- 7** People learn by example – appreciate quality performance 
- 8** Allow the coach to play their role 
- 9** Never ridicule or admonish a young person 
- 10** Encourage amicable disagreement resolution 
- 11** Show appreciation for volunteers and administrators 
- 12** Support all efforts to remove bad or abusive language

Never participate under the influence of alcohol or drugs



Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others



Respect the spirit of fair play in hockey



Conduct yourself in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect your safety and the safety of others



Promote the reputation of the sport and take all possible steps to prevent it from being brought into disrepute



Protect others involved in the game from verbal or physical abuse and threatening or intimidating behaviour



Set a positive example for others, particularly young participants and spectators

SAFEGUARDING POLICY

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

PROTECTING YOUNG PEOPLE



HOCKEY
WALES



The safety and welfare of young people is paramount.



All young people, regardless of age, ability, sex, race, religion or belief, ethnic origin, social status or sexual orientation have the right to be protected from harm



The rights, dignity and worth of all young people should always be respected

Hockey Wales wishes to promote a telling culture. Everyone within hockey must therefore report all concerns in accordance with Hockey Wales' reporting procedures



It is the responsibility of child protection experts to determine whether or not abuse has taken place, but it is everyone's responsibility within hockey to report concerns



Any policy or procedure is only as effective as the ability and skill of those who operate it

The roles and responsibilities of the statutory agencies in safeguarding young people must be recognised and the procedures of the Local Safeguarding Children Boards must be complied with



Hockey Wales is committed to encouraging the effective and safe recruitment of all individuals working with young people in hockey, and everyone within hockey must recognise and regard this as paramount



All those working in hockey, in a paid or voluntary capacity, must abide by Hockey Wales' Code of Ethics / Code of Practice


